You may make your application at any time but if you want to vote by post at a particular election you must make your application before 4pm on the 4th day before that election.

If you tick the box indicating that you wish to vote by post at all elections your name will be included on the postal voters register until you cease to be an elector or you ask for your name to be removed from the register.

The Returning Officer will automatically send you postal voting papers every time there is an election in your electorate.
