The Shire of Coorow is committed to supporting the not-for-profit community & sporting groups, and individuals to deliver their valuable programs and projects to benefit the local community through the Shire Community Grants Program.

The Shire of Coorow offers a number of grant funding schemes for not-for-profit community & sporting groups, and individuals. Please see below the types of grants and funding available to the community:

- **Community Grants**, a grant that allows not-for-profit community & sporting groups to apply for up to \$5,000 for each application.
- **Quick Grants**, a grant that allows not-for-profit organization, community & sporting groups to apply for up to \$750 for each application. Grants open throughout the year.
- **Youth Professional Development**, a grant that allows young people aged 18 years and under, who are seeking financial assistance in areas to apply for up to \$500 for each application that will benefit their development and leadership and consequently the development of the community. Grants open throughout the year.

With the success of the Shire Community Grants Program 2022/2023, it will now **replace** the Shire Community Forums Program. Applications for the next annual Shire Community Grants Program 2023/2024 is **OPEN** from **1st March until 30th April 2023**.
